The Committee of the second International Graduate Legal Research Conference (IGLRC) invites graduate students undertaking legal research to propose abstracts of papers for consideration for the Conference.

The Conference will take place over two days at King's College London in the heart of London's legal quarter. The aim of the Conference is to give graduate students in law from across Europe and the world the opportunity to present papers reflecting excellence in legal research. It will provide a forum for debate, the exchange of ideas, and the furtherance of knowledge.

The closing date for receipt of abstracts is 8 March 2008. Successful applicants will be informed by 23 March 2008. The authors of abstracts selected for presentations will be expected to submit completed papers (with a maximum length of 6,000 words) by 23 April 2008. The Committee will endeavour to secure publication of the best papers presented at the Conference.
